Volunteers of America Delaware Valley administers over 450 units across six sites.

Brittin Village

Located at the former Brittin Reserve Army Training Center in Pennsauken, New Jersey, Brittin Village is 66-unit, quality family and veteran rental housing community.

The Lofts at 2601

Designed for adults who are formerly or imminently facing homelesssness with a documented disability, the Lofts at 2601 offer 56 units of affordable housing.

Lindenwold Towers

Staffed with a full-time Service Coordinator, Lindenwold Towers is our dedicated senior housing. Income qualified seniors ages 62 and over are eligible.

Waterfront Village

Located on seven scenic acres, Waterfront Village is a 70-unit, three story affordable housing community and independent living program for adults ages 55 and over.

Centerton Village

With units specifically set aside for veterans, Centerton Village is a 103-unit workforce housing development rental community for families.
