PAROLE SERVICES

Volunteers of America Delaware Valley has a proven record of commitment, experience, versatility, and competence in operating community reintegration programs and reentry services. Our outlook combines diverse experiences with “state of the art” program approaches. As a result, this creates a client-centered treatment team that is available to respond to the needs of the clients. Our goal is to use effective treatment models that have been empirically tested and shown to reduce the probability of future criminal activity which results in recidivism reduction. VOADV provides evidence-based treatment interventions to clients in an effort to reduce the risk of re-offending and promote successful reintegration into society.



ADDICTION TREATMENT PROGRAM

The Addiction Treatment Program (ATP) provides services to clients returning from the criminal justice system. The goal is to treat the needs of the client in a way to reduce the likelihood of recidivism and/or relapse. At the same time, the program aims to increase the likelihood for continued success on parole supervision and beyond. Treatment begins with a case assessment to build a treatment plan designed around the client’s individual needs. The program includes cognitive-behavioral intervention, motivational enhancement, relapse prevention therapy, and trauma-informed care.

COMMUNITY RESOURCE CENTER

The Community Resource Center (CRC) is a day reporting center for individuals under parole supervision. CRC provides a highly supportive and structured environment for individuals who are identified as needing assistance in their transition back to community life.

FAMILY VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM

The Family Violence Prevention Program is a comprehensive treatment program for perpetrators of domestic violence, providing treatment, counseling and accountability support services. The program’s mission is to help batterers identify, address, and correct the core issues of their problems. Services enable them to become responsible family members and useful adults. As a result, clients develop skills to help eliminate violent behavior patterns and take responsibility for their actions.

PROMISE

PROMISE (Program for Returning Offenders with Mental Illness Safely and Effectively) is a residential mental health and substance abuse treatment program for adults on parole supervision. The program offers transitional and supportive housing upon program completion for those at risk of homelessness.
